Nevada Indian Commission - 2600 Legislative Approved Budget = \$20,991,447* Available Balance = \$10,349,299 Stewart Indian School Cultural Center - 2601 Legislative Approved Budget = \$428,677 Available Balance = \$203,744

Gift Fund

FY2023 Balance = \$57,545

*Includes \$20 million for ARPA subgrants, \$245,585 for administration fees of those grants, \$110,064 for opioid prevention coordinator. NIC budget includes 75% funding from General Fund and \$89,833 funding from NDTCA. SISCCM budget includes 38% funding from General Fund and \$267,618 from NDTCA.

NOTABLES

- Nevada Recovery Funds / American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) applications approved and deliver of \$714,000 pending to three Tribal Nations (Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, Winnemucca Indian Colony, and Walker River Paiute Tribe). Five applications pending approval from GFO. Three applications returned for revisions, and NIC assisting 18 other Tribes with application. New deadline for application submission, Thursday, February 29, 2024
- Helped facilitate collaboration between Silver State Health Insurance Exchange and Tribal Health Directors regarding health coverage for non-insured Tribal citizens, paid by Tribal governments to save healthcare costs; On-line application currently being built
- In September 2023, Nevada Indian Commission assigned new Governor's Office team leads: Tim Robb and Chase McNamara
- Launched civic engagement taskforce to address election services and legislature system to support statewide, nonpartisan focus on Native American matters;
 Commissioners Tiger, Wadsworth and Emm attended the event, September 20-22, 2023
